- 1. Only one entry per person in each class. Entries may be restricted in number according to venue space. Late entries may be considered at discretion of Show Committee.
- 2. Exhibits must be the individual competitor's own work. Plagiarised designs will be down-pointed in judging process.
- 3. Entries close 23 August 2024. All entries are to be made on official Registration Form by email or post by this date.
- 4. All bench tables covered with black cloth. All entries to be judged from front and sides, unless stated otherwise in the Schedule.
- 5. Fresh horticultural material MUST predominate over all other components of exhibit unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. Use of artificial material is prohibited in any exhibit.
- 6. Fresh horticultural material MUST remain turgid for duration of Show.
- 7. Exhibits may not be changed after Judging. The Judge's decision is final. Chief Adjudicator for the Convention is Eileen Wenn OAM.
- 8. Competitors unable to fulfil their ENTRY commitments must notify the Show Secretary, Raymond Bradley, prior to the event.
- 9. Painted, artificially coloured horticultural material may be used with discretion. No aerosol painting allowed inside venue.
- 10. Do not converse with other competitors during staging. Keep your own equipment within your allotted areas. Clean up and leave area once staging is finished.
- 11. No photographs or electronic transmission allowed until after Awards announced. Images remain the property of AFAA.
- 12. Staging times include cleaning up your area. It is each exhibitor's responsibility to cause no water damage or any other damage to venue.
- 13. No assistance may be given to the exhibitor in preparation or construction of exhibit except at the discretion of Stewards, e.g. to assist with heavy object.
- 14. Judging will take place by accredited AFAA Judges in accordance with AFAA 2024 Manual.
- 15. Dismantling from 12 noon, Friday 27 September, 2024. Any items not removed by 6.00pm Friday 27 September 2024, will be disposed of by the organisers.

- Open to all Australian residents NOT attending the 2024 AFAA Convention. Registration fee for the Convention is not required.
- Only one entry per person.
- Exhibits must be the individual competitor's own work. Plagiarised designs will be down-pointed in judging process.
- Fresh and/or dried horticultural material MUST predominate over all other components of exhibit.
- Use of artificial plant material is prohibited.
- Painted, artificially coloured horticultural material may be used with discretion.
- Image Requirements: Format: jpg, png, Resolution: minimum for clarity 300dpi, Angles: front only; Background: Plain background (white or black).
- Construction notes and horticultural material list must accompany the image submission.
- Images submitted become the property of AFAA and will be screened during the Convention, placed on the AFAA website and associated social media.
- No electronic transmission of submitted images permitted until after Awards announced.
- Judging will take place by an international panel of judges in accordance with AFAA 2024 Manual.
- Entry submission closes Friday 23 August 2024.
 Details of entry submission will be provided when registration opens 3 June 2024.

During this time Myhanh also competed in various Interflora Competitions where she was awarded Victorian Florist of the Year in 2016 and 2018. In 2018, she received 3rd place in the Interflora Australia Cup held at MIFGS.

After selling the business, Myhanh worked for Interflora Australia as the Area Manager for Victoria for a short period. Now in a full circle, Myhanh has returned to Melbourne Polytechnic where she teaches floristry full-time.

Alongside her colleagues, Myhanh is passionate about embedding sustainable floristry principles in vocational education and is on the advisory team for the Sustainable Floristry Network.



Over the years, Myhanh has also demonstrated for various floral art groups and is very excited and honoured to have been invited to demonstrate and facilitate the workshops for the 2024 Southeastern Splendour Convention.

Transport

Regular domestic flights are direct to Canberra from all capital cities. The venue is 8.5kms from the airport. There are taxi and Uber ranks just outside the baggage claim area.

For those travelling from Sydney, Canberra is an easy three-hour drive via the motorways.

REGISTRATION

All participants are required to register (\$80/\$40). We have tried to keep this cost as low as possible to cover the venue hire and refreshments and other costs involved in staging a large event. All registrants will receive a bag containing convention details, tickets and badges, as well as tourist information, maps, and freebies.

OFFICIAL OPENING & AWARD CEREMONY

The official Opening and Award Ceremony will take place on Wednesday 25 September 2024 at 6.45pm for 7.00pm. This will be followed by Myhanh Rutledge's Demonstration. Attendees will have an exclusive viewing of the exhibits at this time. Cost: \$70.

CONVENTION DINNER

A Convention Dinner will be held on the evening of Thursday 26 September 2024 at 6.30pm for a 7.00pm start. A 2-course table service dinner plus an after dinner buffet (selection of desserts, cheese and fruit), will be served and a cash bar will be available for drinks. Cost: \$65.00.
